

## RECORD OF OATH OF OFFICE

Reference: Republic of Texas Constitution, Article V, Section 2, as amended by Amendment Article 2. "Except as provided in the 1836 Constitution each and every one elected or appointed to a government position, before entering into their duties, must take and subscribe the following oath or affirmation to wit: \_\_\_\_\_\_(state their full name) are you willing to take this Oath? (Proper answer is "I am willing."), Section 3. "Every person who shall be chosen or appointed to any office of trust or profit shall, before entering on the duties thereof, take an oath to support the constitution of the republic, and also an oath of office."

Administrator of Oath asks of the Oath Taker :

\_\_\_\_\_(state their full name) are you willing to take this Oath? (Proper answer is "I am willing.")

"I, <u>Susan-ann: Miller</u>, do solemnly declare, by my own word (state your full name)

and hand without reservation, to the People of Texas that I will faithfully

execute the duties of the office of <u>Chief Justice</u> and to the best (office elected or appointed)

of My abilities preserve, protect, defend, and obey, the constitution and

the Laws of the Republic of Texas, so help me Almighty God."
